Wildlife Habitat Stewards Sought

The National Wildlife Federation and the Pennsylvania Wildlife Federation are looking for a few dedicated individuals to train as Habitat Stewards volunteers. Once trained, these volunteers will be a resource for their communities to assist people who want to create a landscape that is wildlife-friendly and good for the environment. Volunteers will be able to teach people how to get their backyards, schools, work places, or other community sites certified by NWF as official Wildlife Habitat sites.

The training will include guest speakers and topics such as Gardening for Birds, Why Native Plants, Planting for Wildlife, Planting for Reptiles and Amphibians, and other habitat topics. The Habitat Stewards training will take place at the Warwick Hotel, Hummelstown, PA (near Hershey and Harrisburg), on the following dates:

Saturday April 17th 8:30 am, 4:30 pm
Tuesday April 20th 6:00 pm, 9:00 pm
Thursday April 22nd 6:00 pm, 9:00 pm

All three sessions should be attended. The Pennsylvania Wildlife Federation will pay the training costs so there is no charge for attendees.
