Shrubs: Aronia melanocarpa - black chokeberry Ilex glabra - white-fruited inkberry Juniperus virginiana - red juniper (low, spreading selection) Myrica pensylvanica - Northern bayberry (female plants w/ aromatic silvery fruit & persistent winter foliage) Cornus sericea - red-osier dogwood (green leaves w/ wide white margin, yellow stems in winter)

Perennials:

Campanula americana - tall bellflower Heliopsis helianthoides - false sunflower Monarda punctata - spotted bee-balm Spiranthes cernua odorata - nodding ladies's tresses orchid

Ferns:

Dryopteris x australis - dixie fern Dryopteris marginalis - marginal wood fern Polystichum acrostichoides - Christmas fern Thelypteris palustris - marsh fern
