The SmartWood Program of the Rainforest Alliance is conducting a Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) forest management/chain of custody certification pre-assessment and assessment of the Allegheny National Forest (ANF) located in Warren, PA, USA. SmartWood will conduct the FSC pre-assessment and assessment as part of a pilot project sponsored by The Pinchot Institute for Conservation. This pilot project includes dual assessments of the ANF to both FSC and Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) forest certification standards. The SFI certification assessments will be conducted concurrent with the FSC assessments with a single, merged assessment team. PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC) will be conducting the SFI assessment.

This test will provide the Forest Service with information to assess the potential costs and benefits of the possible application of third-party certification to portions of the National Forest System lands. Actual certification of the ANF is not the objective of this effort, and is explicitly outside the scope of the test assessment.

As a part of the FSC certification assessment process, SmartWood invites stakeholders to offer comments and feedback on ANF forest management.
